

Alumni Board of Directors Expectations

These are some of the traditional responsibilities of membership on the Board:

- Abide by the duties of Board membership as defined by non-profit law (below)
- It is an expectation that 100% of those serving on the Board of Directors will make a financial contribution to the college at a level that is comfortable for the individual Board member
- Attend 4-5 Alumni Board Meetings a year, at least one yearly at an off campus location.
- Serve on one or more PSC Alumni Association committees: (Alumni/Student Affairs, Historical, Awards, By-Laws/Procedure/Policy, Nominating, Campground, Development, Social/Reunion), and attend committee meetings that may occur at times other than an at regularly scheduled Board meetings
- Volunteer to help with the many activities of the Association such as:
- participate in local alumni events near their home locations
- assist with recruitment of High School and Community College students to PSC
- assist with fund raising events that support the college
- assist College staff with Alumni Association events such as Sugarbush Breakfast, Reunion Weekend, and regional/Compass Club events
- assist on Alumni Campground work days
