



Articulation Agreement

Between

Paul Smith's College
Paul Smiths, NY

and

Southwest Tech BOCES
Bennington, VT

This Agreement establishes which credits will transfer from the Culinary program at Southwest Tech BOCES into Paul Smith's College.

Terms of the Agreement

1. When students apply to Paul Smith's College they must indicate their participation in their high school's program on the application.
2. Upon acceptance into Paul Smith's College, students will be eligible to receive transfer credit under the terms of this articulation agreement.
3. Given successful completion of their school's program, students will receive 3 general elective credits which will be credited per the table below.

Period of Agreement

This agreement will become effective immediately, and shall be reviewed and updated May 31, 2030, or when substantive changes are made in the curriculum of either Paul Smith's College or Southwest Tech BOCES. Both Paul Smith's College and Southwest Tech BOCES reserve the right to withdraw from the agreement by submitting written notice of intent at least 4 months prior to the start of the academic year.
